

## Lab 6: Float!



### Lab Instructions:

1. You'll continue working on the web page you made last time! Create a **copy of lab5.html** and name this file **lab6.html**. Make sure the file is still saved in the **Desktop -> cs@sc** folder!
2. Open Sublime Text. Click **File -> Open** and open up the newly created **lab6.html**.
3. Open up **lab6.html** in your Chrome browser as well, by opening Chrome then click **File -> Open** to navigate to **lab6.html**.
4. In Lab 5, you create a number of <div>s to create "sections" in your web page. Pick any two <div>s (not the header or footer if possible) and add a width and float properties to them to make them go **next to each other**. See sample below for an example.
5. Don't forget to clear the float after the floating the two <div>s next to each other. To clear the float:
  - a. Create an empty <div> with a class **clearfloat** right after the second div is closed.
  - b. In the <style> tag, add the following CSS rule for this class:

```
.clearfloat {  
    clear: both;  
}
```

6. **Horizontally center** these two <div>s. To do so, create another <div **class="row">** around the two column <div>s. Set a width to <div **class="row">** and center it. Some arithmetic needed to make sure all the divs stay in one row.
